This would be approached through emergency employment that will offer cash for work to community members who will benefit from immediate cash injection into their communities and homes for basic supplies as well as assist with longer term stability. Participation will be gender-balanced and focus on debris collection, for classification, recycling and proper disposal. To facilitate re-use and longer term income sources, a carpentry workshop will be established, to convert lumber debris into building materials and produce furniture to replace that lost in the cyclone, and local men and women trained in basic carpentry techniques.
